1DayLA

In 2020 and 2021, in the midst of a pandemic and national division, this philosophy and strategy was applied for the first time in the city of Los Angeles, CA.



641 Faith Communities officially partnered.

\$47 Million in medical debt for 23,000 families in LA County paid off.

+2,000 families took the first step to foster, adopt, or care for families in crisis.

35 California State Prisons streamed messages of hope to inmates. Over 3,500 in attendance each week.

+100,000 families served throughout the 1DayLA campaign.












IGNITING A MOVEMENT OF LOVE TO CHANGE A CITY

We believe the Great Commission is not just a mobilization mandate, but a leadership mandate. Jesus defines the highest level of leadership as service. By activating the Church around long-term, sustainable initiatives, local churches will be reintroduced as the key servants, and therefore, key leaders in the city.

THE PROBLEM CYCLE

We want to help solve the obstacles in a community that have yet to be solved. We believe many of the major challenges in Houston are perpetuated by an ongoing problem cycle.



Families in crisis are a key driver of issues facing our cities. Families in crisis open the door statistically to higher levels of neglect. When the state steps in and neglected, vulnerable children are removed from their families of origin, the foster care system becomes overburdened. Research shows that children who get "stuck" in the foster care system and age out without a permanent family statistically will end up on one of five difficult paths:



will be homeless in 2 years



of girls are parents by age 21



will spend one night in prison



have been out of work in the last year



of youth recovered in human trafficking rings were in the foster care system



How Do We Create Change?

We focus on initiatives that close the cycle, addressing not just the symptoms, but the root causes behind our city's most deeply entrenched problems. By rallying churches, businesses, nonprofits, government, and thousands of volunteers to team-tackle these issues on an unprecedented scale, we can create new solutions for the long term.

REBRAND THE CHURCH AS 'THE ONES WHO LOVE'

THROUGH A DAY OF MONUMENTAL SERVICE Spring 2023

Today, if you were to ask many American nonbelievers their impression of Christians and Christianity, the response would often range from indifferent to hostile. We plan to rally 50,000 people and hundreds of local churches to empower the city in a widespread, transformative way. The ten-year qualitative goal of this moment is that the logical conclusion of atheists and agnostics when they hear the word "church" or "Christian" will be: "Those are the people who love no matter what."

That day, Serve Centers will host school events, beautification projects, sports clinics, building projects, aid distribution, and solution-based initiatives.

Volunteers from Houston will unite to empower their community.

Faith communities in Houston will be transformed into Serve Centers.

Major public middle & high schools implementing social and emotional learning programs for students.

In medical debt eradicated in Houston.

Gift in kind distribution via sustainable Serve Center/CityServe partnerships.


